After hearing a case No 6034/2004 and in order to rule has taken cognizance of the following:

The legal procedure is under Article 489 of the Code of Civil Procedure on the grounds of the petition under Article 6,
Article 17 and Article 18 of the Law on non-profit legal entities/SG issue 81/06.10.2000.

It is formed with reference to the petition of the Managing Board of an association by the name of Club-Journalists

Against Corruption which requires its registration into the special register of the court to non-profit legal entities.

On the basis of the collected written evidence the court assumes as established the following factual and legal situation:

A record is to certify a constituent meeting of the association at which was decided unanimously to establish a non-profit
legal entity – association for public benefit activities; establishing statutes; electing managing board.

On the basis of the written evidence, the court concluded:

The petition is well-grounded and should be taken into consideration.

It is evident that the decision for a non-profit legal entity established by 19 physical persons is valid. The given name

should be adopted and registered in this verbal expression as it does not coincide with the name of another organization

registered so far – Article 7 of the Law on non-profit legal entities. The statutes of the association contain regulations on

all subject to registration conditions stated in Article 18 and Article 20 of the law. The objectives of the association determine

it as an organization for public benefit. The objectives are not of the category prohibited by the laws and the constitution of the
country.

Because of all that, as was stated availability of all subject to registration conditions, and since the court assumed that their

registration is admissible under Article 496 of the Code of Civil Procedure in connection to Article 6 and Article 18 of the Law on non-profit legal entities.

RULED:

The court registers in the registry of non-profit legal entities Association named:
CLUB-JOURNALISTS AGAINST CORRUPTION

with headquarters and address in Sofia, quarter of Lozenets, 14 a Nikolay Liliev str., floor 1

With objectives: To give and popularize among civil society clear, accurate and unambiguous definition of the term “corruption”

in all its forms. To create public intolerance against corruption among civil society. To stimulate the civil society to real anti-

corruption actions in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Bulgaria. To give possibility to the members of civil society, through discussions, to make proposals for fighting corruption. To create self-confidence and consciousness in the Bulgarian citizen that he is a member of a legal and democratic civil society which defends its rights and jointly performs its duties. The means for achieving the objectives of the association are: engaging the opinion of experts – jurists, representatives of other NGOs, journalists and others working against corruption, as well as the attention of competent bodies of the legislative and executive power. Participation with attitudes on discussion of bills concerning corruption and the journalists’ ethical code. At discussions will be explained in detail and clearly the current legislation and the possibilities for opposing corruption on the part of citizens. Civil society will be stimulated by broadcasting, discussions, media articles to oppose corruption. By participation in different profit-yielding, permitted by the laws of the country, initiatives for collecting money, activities for accumulation of resources and property to be used in realization of the association’s objectives, carrying out information and other activities for popularizing the objectives and activities of the association in the country and abroad. The association carries out information activities abroad. The association works in cooperation with similar governmental and non-governmental organizations. The association can perform also supplementary economic activity which is connected with its main activity. The receipts from the supplementary economic activity are used for achieving the objectives of the association.

The association is not term-limited.

The association is formed for carrying out public benefit activity.

The association has the following object of activity: Mediation in the following activities: organizing meetings, seminars, training of its members and of the persons connected with the activities of the association, publishing and distributing activities, publicity and public relations activities; organizing education courses, club activities, consulting, advertising, information programs, mediation services.

The regulations for establishment and termination of the membership are stated in Article 12-13 of the Statutes.
